I'm Afraid to Get Married while I Have Past Baggage that Haunts Me?

I understand seeking God and praying for forgiveness and that when he so chose to give me salvation through Christ my sins of past present and future were all forgiven. However, how do I deal with and move on the scars that past sin has left. I'm afraid to even think about a Christian marriage for myself because of the baggage my past brings into the marriage. Marriage Guidance: It's very true, we never FORGET our past but our SINCERE relationship with Christ <u>cleanses us and frees us from our past!</u> Because of the love of Christ we are given a second chance to be RENEWED in our Spirit. You are still living in your old man body and ways, rather than allowing yourself to be renewed. Most people do this and they don't even realize it; AND THAT'S WHY THEY REMAIN SLAVES TO SIN! <u>They allow sin to control them.</u>

In Fact some people think (not to offend but to enlighten) all they need to do is go up to the altar in a church building and eat some bread and drink some wine or grape juice and they are saved. Some folks think that just because they BELIEVE in God and are BAPTIZED, they are saved. On the contrary, participating in these religious, symbolic ceremonies and rites DOES NOT SAVE US! These things are

something one can choose to do if they want but they don't save us or provide us with a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

Jesus is all about LOVE not RELIGION: One plus one does equal two, meaning participating in religion and its political schemes is what KEEPS PEOPLE OUT OF THE KINGDOM OF HEAVEN! We need to have a one on one relationship with Christ!

## There are two types of sins that humans interact with.

Christ ones are human in this fleshly stage of life and this is why you *feel the flesh* pulling at you; your mind and heart are wanting to do what is right as a Christian man, while your body is pulling you to be a slave to sin. It's called temptation. The churches love to blame this temptation on the satan, because it makes the sin justified in some way. It does not matter where the sin came from, what matters is that we choose to not be controlled by it!

**However, it's all about choice.** We can choose to allow Jesus Christ to be a part of our life or we can choose to go our own way. The problem is if we do not have the FAITH and TRUST to let God lead our lives and protect us from sin, then we will succumb to it. God leaves the choices up to us so we must choose wisely.

No one who lives in Him keeps on sinning. No one who continues in sin has either seen him or knows him. Dear children do not let anyone lead you astray... 1 John 3:6-7

### WE ALL SIN BUT WE ALL ARE NOT SLAVES TO IT!

The difference is this. A Christ one may have the thought to look at another person with feelings of lust but realizes instantly that it is not true and sincere Christian Living, and the Spirit of Christ within them intervenes and keeps them from acting out. We absolutely have to have a relationship with God through Jesus Christ. Only God can heal our wretched lives.

It is a struggle between the flesh and the spirit and it can be difficult to control. But God is good and provides a way out of temptation. This is why, <u>as Christ ones we MUST keep our eye on Jesus every day of our lives</u> and doing that makes our

lifestyle a Christ-like example for others we are married to and any others we interact with on a daily basis.

We'll never be like Christ while we have this human body, but we can put all of our trust and faith in Him and allow Him to go to work in our life, while walking in the fleshly body in this world, and He WILL keep us from giving into our temptations! Why do I know this? God says so and because of seeing results in my own life. I do not need to see Christ to know He is real; I see Christ working in my life daily!! Once you live your life for Jesus Christ, putting your faith and trust in Him, temptations become easier and easier to deal with until they completely dissipate from your life...and that is because you have the Spirit of Jesus Christ in YOU, protecting you from the world. Your mind is with Christ, not on worldly thoughts and tempting situations.

There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it. 1 Corinthians 10:13 KJV

You see from the above scripture that temptations are common to us all. Do you think you are the only one that is tempted in the world? But here is the good part:

God is faithful (this is why we need to put our life in his hands) and will not allow us to be tempted above that we can bear!! The scripture goes on to say,"

God will make a way for us to escape from temptation! I've always said only the courageous can walk away from tempting situations because Jesus Christ within us gives us the strength through HIM!!

You see, there is a big difference between saying "I believe in God" or "I have faith in God" vs. actually "Living your life for God" **because you believe in HIM.** People think they need to "go to church", or they think they need to be "dogooders", or they think they need to do "this" or "that" to be saved. Sadly they have been deceived and most people waste their valuable time chasing God while God is already knocking at their door, but yet they never allow Him in.

Yes, going to 99.95% of churches today keep people from entering into the kingdom of heaven...because all they talk about is all the things you gotta do to reach the kingdom of heaven; and all these people are just patiently waiting for

Jesus to come down on a puff cloud, as a knight in shining armor and take them to the kingdom of heaven.

What they have not been told is that the Kingdom of Heaven is already here! Jesus is already here!! Sadly the churches stunt people's spiritual growth and that is "why" the way in to heaven is so narrow and few enter in...they are still waiting for something to happen... and then they die.

We have to live for Jesus Christ TODAY! We have to allow Him to go to work in our lives NOW. He is the only one who can renew our spirit from the darkness of the world. We are still in the world but Jesus brings us <u>out of</u> the world and make us new men and women in Him!

#### Put on the New Man

And have put on the new man, which is <u>renewed in knowledge</u> after the image of him that created him: Colossians 3:10 JKV

The key in the above scripture is in having the RENEWED KNOWLEDGE to become like (*in the image of*) Christ; hence the saying "Christ-like". The new man is no longer spiritually blind to the works of Christ within Him... The new man or woman is <u>transformed</u> in heart, mind and soul; <u>and they no longer allow sin to control their lives</u>. (see below)

The person with RENEWED knowledge has put God FIRST above all other people and things, and strives to follow Jesus and be like Jesus *(in the image of)* in *everything* they do.

And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the <u>renewing of your mind</u>, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God. Romans 12: 2 KJV

You see, there it is again in another scripture, renewing of your mind.

<u>Jesus renews our mind</u> and gives us the knowledge and faith to do the right things and be good people. When our minds are renewed in the knowledge of our Father that is when we can REALLY begin to put our trust and faith in God through His Son, Jesus Christ.

#### Slave to Sin

For when ye were the servants of sin, ye were free from righteousness. Romans 6:20 KJV.

Christ said, no man can serve two masters, you'll hate one and love the other. You are either a Christ-one or you are a person of the world. We all have a choice to choose what and who we are going to be. What are you going to be? Who are you going to be? Are you going to be a new man / woman in Christ, or are you going to allow the world to dictate your life? Choose!
